MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This confirms the intent of Lackawanna County to file an application for a second round filing with the Broadband Infrastructure Application Submission to NTIA (BTOP) for a county-wide, carrier-grade, multi-service network to benefit the county.

The Lackawanna County Goal – Lackawanna County will work with CONXX to file an application for a broadband stimulus project available as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 in a timely manner.

CONXX Goal – To work with Lackawanna County, and third parties identified by the county, to collect data, construct a design, and assist in preparing a broadband application. The complete requirements will be defined by the Notice of Funds Available (NoFA) by the RUS and BTIA for the second round of funding, including required pro formas.

Process - To work with Lackawanna County to expeditiously prepare and submit a Broadband Infrastructure Application that meets the requirements of the county.

Lackawanna County will-

1. Work with CONXX in a diligent and timely manner to provide information required to define sections for the filing.
2. Provide open disclosure of information required to complete an accurate application and properly position the county to ensure a cooperative and successful application.
3. County will identify the required matching resources required to apply for a round 2 submission.
4. Financial obligation due to CONXX, Inc. as a result of this agreement: The County will pay CONXX a retainer of \$11,000.00 (eleven thousand dollars) for all work required to complete and submit the BTOP grant application.
5. Work with CONXX to define the preferred technology for the delivery of the necessary services in the grant application.

Obligations of CONXX, Inc. –

1. To work with the Lackawanna County in a diligent and timely manner to develop the submission, as well as provide adequate and qualified resources and professional experts as necessary for the completion of the grant submission.
2. To provide explanations, clarifications, and requirements of the NoFA, before the submission process begins.
3. To ensure the application submittal process meets the understood requirements of NoFA associated with the Round 2 filing.
4. Fully support the project plan as defined for the submittal process.

Both Parties are in agreement with the intent outlined by this Memorandum.
